General Rules:

- 1. Driver must be 16 or have Parental/Guardian permission.
- 2. Hook fee is due at time of sign in 9:00 am at track.
- 3. Tractors must not exceed speed limit for class. Driver will be able to go half the track to adjust speed till horn stops. If horn blows after ½ track mark, tractor is disqualified.
- 4. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times.
- 5. Drivers must remain seated at all times and maintain complete control of vehicle at all times.
- 6. NO one permitted on track except for track officials and contestant when vehicle is under the green flag.
- 7. Tractors must start pull with a tight chain. **NO jerking permitted.** Contestant will have 2 pulls to move sled. If driver lets off throttle before 75', he may have a second attempt. If no effort is made to back off, NO second attempt will be given. An attempt is defined as moving the sled a distance of 1" or greater.
- 8. Pulling Tractor must remain within boundaries of track during pull or will be disqualified.
- 9. Pull will be considered over when forward motion of load stops and judge raises red flag. Judges will keep hole digging to a minimum.
- 10. <u>ANY</u> loss of parts or weights or excessive loss of liquid during pull will be cause for termination of pull or red flag. Judges discretion on the term "excessive".
- 11. Maximum drawbar height is 20". Drawbar must be stationary in all directions and parallel to ground. The area around drawbar must be free from any obstructions, including weights. Hook hole must be 3" wide and 3 ½ " long.
- 12. Wheelie Bars are <u>HIGHLY</u> recommended (Mandatory for all open classes). Tractors with a cab or roll bar will be excluded from being required to have wheelie bars.
- 13. WORKING Kill Switches are HIGHLY recommended (Mandatory for all open classes)
- 14. No weights permitted on platform, cab, or 3pt hitch arms. Weights **MUST** be securely fastened to tractor.
- 15. No dual wheels, MFWD, or articulated 4WD tractors allowed.
- 16. No added blowers (turbo classes excluded), LP gas injectors or alcohol fuel systems.
- 17. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe will be disqualified or barred from hooking. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED DURING PULL.
- 18. Judges or promoters or sled operators decision is final at all times during pull. **NO EXCPETIONS!**
- 19. Be kind and respectful to the help. If you have a problem or complaint speak to the pull director.

General Antique Pull Rules: All classes

1. Drivers under 16 must have Parental/Guardian permission.

2. Drivers must stay in seat of tractor at all times. Hands must be on throttle, hand clutch or steering wheel during pull. Feet must stay on platform at all times during pull.

3. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe will be disqualified or barred from hooking. NO

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED DURING PULL.

4. ANY tractor parts falling off (weights, fly covers, etc.) while hooked to sled will be a D.Q.

5. Tractors must stay in bounds at time of pull.

6. Wheelie bars are HIGHLY recommended (IT IS MANDATORY FOR TRACTORS IN ALL OPEN CLASSES). Any tractor that does not have wheelie bars must use a clevis with a shoe. NO **EXCEPTIONS!**

7. WORKING KILL SWITCHES are **HIGHLY** recommended. (IT IS MANDATORY FOR TRACTORS IN ALL OPEN CLASSES) NO EXCEPTIONS!

- 8. Draw bars will be 20" max height. Must be stationary in ALL directions. Tractors with a clevis, clevis must be secured to drawbar with bolt or pin.
- 9. ONE HOOK PER TRACTOR PER CLASS. Unless the sled is reweighed or track is watered down.

10. Weights must be securely fastened to tractor. (Wheelbase must be stock for model of tractor).

11. No steel wheels. Two wheel drive only. No duals.

12. Tractors must be naturally aspirated with exception of those that had GM engine.

13. All tractors MUST use factory fan shroud. Engine side panels recommended but not required.

14. MPH will be checked from 1/2 track until the end of the pull. MPH will be checked by sled operator.

15. Tractors must have stock appearing agricultural; engine, transmission, rear end and axle housing or manufacturer's replacement. NO adapter plates allowed for engine, transmission, front end to bolt

16. Enhanced electrical systems permitted in all classes.

17. ANY AG. TYPE CARBURETOR ALLOWED. MUST BE SINGLE BARREL, THROAT (VENTURE) AND SAME DRAFT DIRECTION AS STOCK FOR THAT MODEL.

18. Spacer plates and girdles will have no more than 1" above and below center line of crankshaft. 2" total.

19. ANY JERKING OF SLED OR SIDE STEPPING CLUTCH WILL RESULT IN A D.Q.

20. Judges or promoters or sled operators decision is final at all times during pull. NO EXCPETIONS!

21. Hook hole should be no less than 3" wide & 3 1/2" long.

22. Be kind and respectful to the help. If you have a problem or complaint speak to the pull director.
