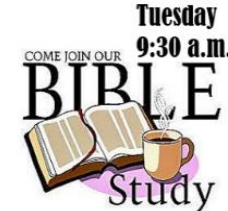

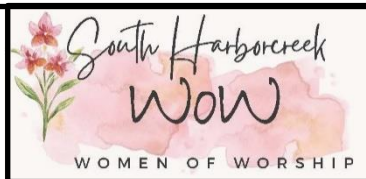

DRUMMER NEEDED

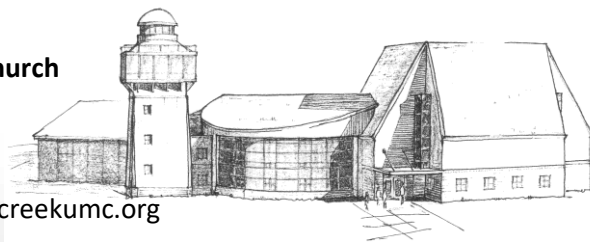
