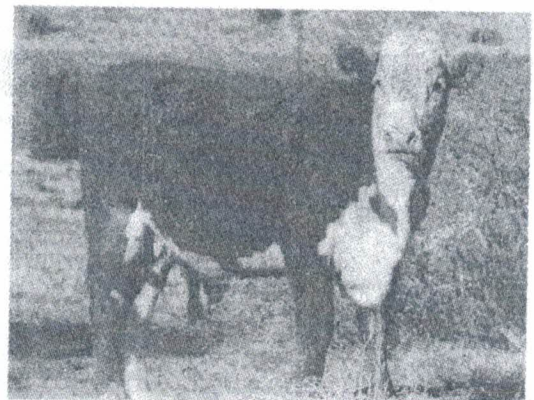

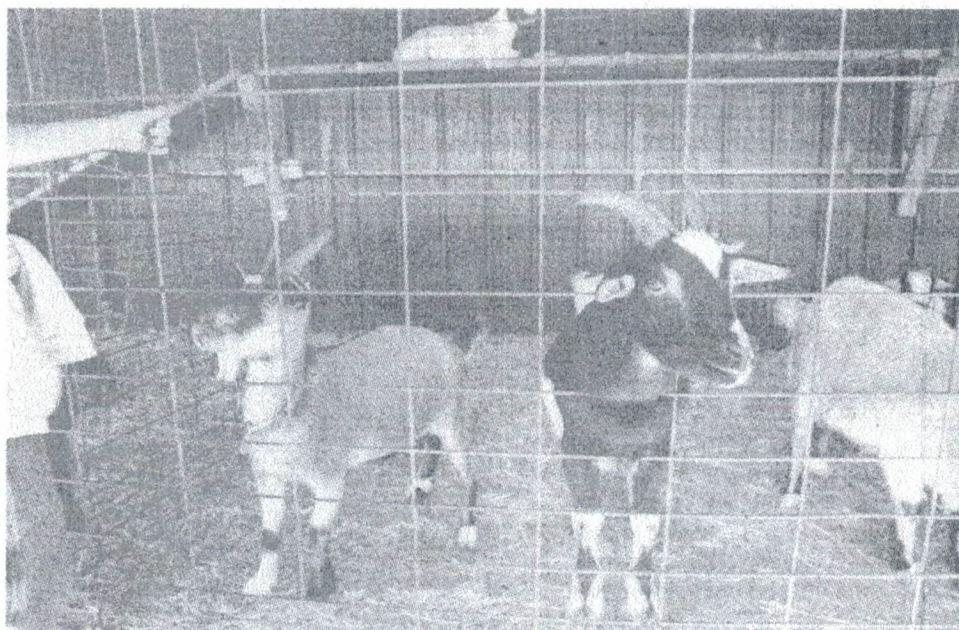

Section 6 - Rabbits (Refer to General Rules)

1. Rabbits will be screened on arrival for health and show condition. No rabbits showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show.
2. Department Superintendents have the final judgment in resolving any dispute.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark.
4. Meat pens may be entered. They must consist of three (3) rabbits, 70 days old or under, weigh a maximum of five (5) pounds and a minimum of three (3) pounds, and be the same breed.

1. Showmanship Contest is open to any youth not entered in 4-H who has a rabbit entered in the breed contest. Exhibitors will compete according to their age as of January 1st (4-H age) with the exception of the Novice Class (1st project year participating in Showmanship.)
2. Rabbit used must be entered and shown in the Fair Rabbit Show and be owned by the exhibitor competing in this department.
3. Exhibitor must meet with the judge and be scored individually. The score will be based on the following: carrying the rabbit to the table, posing, checking ears, teeth, eyes and nose; checking toenails, hocks, front feet, abdomen, legs, and tail; checking sex, checking fur, the exhibitor's appearance, actions, and knowledge. Exhibitor's knowledge will be tested by answering questions related to the breed exhibited, diseases, and standard management practices. The exhibitor is not restricted to a specific order for the presentation.
4. Exhibitor will show in proper attire, which includes a long-sleeved top.

RULES:

- Participant must be an individual amateur baker (age 8 through and including 18 years old) who is a Pennsylvania resident. One entry per person.
- Entrants may not have won 1st place in the PA Preferred™ Junior Baking Contest at any other fair in 2018.
- Entry must be a plate of six (6) individual sized portions of the baked entry item.
- Entries must be made from scratch. Pre-made mixes are not acceptable ingredients.
- PA Preferred™ ingredients must be used in the recipe. A comprehensive list of acceptable products will be available on the PA Preferred™ website. Recipes are to include three (3) out of the five (5) items listed here:

a. Grains such as flour or oats	d. Dairy such as milk, cream or butter
b. Fruit such as peaches, apples or berries	e. Eggs
c. Vegetable such as zucchini or carrots	

- Entry must be submitted for judging on a food safe disposable setting. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
- Recipe(s) must be submitted with the entry, printed on one side of 8-1/2" x 11" paper. Recipe must list all ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. PA Preferred™ ingredients are to be identified in writing as "PA Preferred" along with the brand name in the recipe (ex: PA Preferred Eggs - Weis brand; PA Preferred Milk - Galliker's brand; PA Preferred Berries - Strite's Orchards). Entrant's name, age, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. PA Preferred™ product labels should be attached to the recipe. (All recipes and cookies-brownies-bars will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- Refrigeration is not available at the fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
