After two (2) years of completion, and 4000 OJT work hours on file with the apprenticeship office, a student is eligible to try for the Electrical Journeyman's License by taking the exam. (Information about the exam can be obtained from the apprenticeship office.)

Many students will wait until they've graduated from the apprenticeship program because there will be information they learn in Years 3 & 4 that may be on the Journeyman's test.

Students that complete all the requirements of the program and the State of Florida receive three (3) certificates:

- 1) A certificate of completion from the Brevard Electrical Apprenticeship Training Program GNJ, Inc.
- 2) A certificate of completion from Atlantic Technical College and Technical High School
- 3) A certificate of completion from the Florida Department of Education

Upon obtaining their Journeyman's License, students are invited to return as an instructor for the apprenticeship program. They are very valuable as an instructor since they understand from a students' point of view what may or may not help others learn.

We receive instructor reviews from the students every year in order to learn from them about their needs and wants. We then have an instructor meeting every June with the BEATP committee to discuss any changes that can and/or should be made.

We at BEATP want to provide a comfortable atmosphere for our students and our instructors as well, so we appreciate their input and ideas on how to make this program a better one for the community of Brevard County.
