Signature wool remnants are limited in size & quantity ~ and **any** remnants not used **must** be returned to the SDSGA.

New this year ~ we are having a special category that will be lots of fun! Be one of the first artists to “dress a SDSU bunny” using the Signature Wool remnants.

Bunnies will be available on a first come basis (limited quantities available) and you can make a sweater, dress, hat & tie, costume, anything for the bunny.

Show off your sewing, crochet or knitting skills!



Prizes will be awarded based on creativity, construction, and wool promotion. Items must be labeled securely with name and contact information of the artist.

Contest items may be delivered to any district contest, or to Patty DeZeeuw at 619-5th Ave, Brookings, SD. Entry deadline is September 25th.

Awards will be presented at the SDSGA/MIWW banquet ~ Sept 30, 2017.

All items entered will be used to generate funds for the SDSU Signature Wool Project scholarship fund. The 2017 contest entries will be auctioned at the “Night at the Museum” lamb social at the SD Ag Heritage Museum on Friday, Sept 29, 2017. Contest participants will receive a free ticket to the event, and will be recognized at the auction.
