#### **LUGO & WILLIAMS BECOME FIRST TIME CHAMPS**

#### **LUGO PREVAILS ON CHALLENGING CONDITIONS**

In the 29-season history of the Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour, there have been close finishes and runaways; there have been some high scoring affairs, and some extremely challenging lane patterns. The 41-foot Turnpike lane pattern at this month's tour stop proved to be one of the most stern tests ever seen.

Lugo, appearing in just his 3rd tour stop, snagged the 8th and final spot in the boy's match play field, and on an ultra-demanding finals condition, proved to be the most consistent player, logging his first 7 matches between 185 and 213, winning 6 of them. That put him 36 pins behind leader Isaac Erickson heading into the position round. There, he saved his best for last, as he matched his best game in the finals, easily dispatching the leader 213-173 and holding on for his first tour title.

#### **CHAMP VICTORIOUS AFTER QUALIFYING 8th**

Lugo qualified 8th, so victory might not have seemed likely, however only 82 pins separated all 8 finalists heading into match play. However, game #16 would be the only time during the entire event that Lugo would hold the lead – but at the end of the day, that's the most important time to be in the lead.

For his 16 tournament games, the champ averaged 202. The native from Mexico took home the championship plaque, the \$350 winner's scholarship and earns a permanent place on Champion's Row. Lugo also became the 124th different champion in boy's division history. Congratulations, Luis!

#### DIERCKS FALLS 1 STRIKE SHORT OF FIRST TOUR WIN

Alex Diercks was in the best form of his tour career at this month's event, as he staged a late rally to try to come from behind to earn victory. After qualifying in 7th place, Diercks entered the 10th and final frame on 4 strikes in a row, and needed a strike in the 10th frame to capture his first tour title. Instead, on a great roll, he left the 4-9, and was forced to settle for runner-up honors. In the 6th finals appearance of his career, the Cedar Rapids resident took home a \$225 scholarship.

#### **ERICKSON PLACES 3rd**

Isaac Erickson was one of 4 different bowlers to hold the lead at some point during the finals this month. He found himself 156 pins out of the lead after 3 games, but fired games of 206, 245, 236 and 215, posting 4 wins along the way to surge into the lead heading into the final game. He struggled early in the final contest, and eventually slid into 3rd place; this matched the highest finish of his tour career, and with it came a \$200 scholarship. The Lititz, Pennsylvania native also finished 3rd at this season's September event in Cedar Rapids.

#### **ZILK TAKES HOME 4th**

Josh Zilk was this month's 4th place finisher; he earned a \$175 scholarship. This marked the 2nd time qualifying for the match play finals for the Virginia Beach, Virginia resident.

#### **LAST MONTH'S CHAMPION JONES EARNED 5th**

William Jones returned to the finals for the 6th time in his career. The native of Anoka, Minnesota earned a \$150 scholarship for his 5th place finish. Jones captured his first title at last month's tour stop in Moline, Illinois.

#### **ABOUD BACK IN FINALS, FINISHES 6th**

Justin Aboud is now 2 for 2 in match play finals appearances in his young tour career. The lanky right-hander from San Jose, California earned a \$125 scholarship for his day's work.

#### **BARBER 7th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT**

Alton Barber enjoyed a breakthrough performance at this month's event. The 2-hander from Bettendorf, lowa qualified for the first match play finals of his career, and it resulted in a 7th place finish; he earned \$110.

#### **DENTON PLACES 8th**

Zack Denton was this month's 8th place finisher; the right-hander from Waverly, Iowa earned a \$100 scholarship for his performance. He was appearing in the 5th match play finals of his tour career.

Dalton Weber took home this month's high game out of the money. The right-hander from Camanche, Iowa earned a \$55 award by firing the highest game of the entire tournament – a sparkling 289 – in his qualifying round.

#### WILLIAMS EARNS FIRST TOUR TITLE

#### WILLIAMS OUTLASTS FIELD TO EARN FIRST GISBT VICTORY

Jenna Williams became a first-time GISBT champion this month. The talented right-handed cranker from Homosassa, Florida grabbed the top seed heading into match play by being the only player in the girl's division to average 200 for her 8-game qualifying block; she averaged 201.50 for her first 8 games. In match play – the 4th of her career, she posted the highest 6-game total by averaging 198.33 for her 6 games. That was good enough to earn her a record of 3 wins and 3 losses. Despite dropping the final position round 192-166 to eventual runner-up Cassidy Courey, she held on for a 62-pin margin of victory.

Williams used her impressive strike ball to navigate the inside of the lane, and that seemed to keep her out of trouble during the event. In winning, she averaged 200.14 for her 14 games. Williams became the 86th different girl's champion in GISBT history, and she became the most recent first-time champion since Addy Nelson captured the first of her 3 titles in September 2019. The spoils of victory included the \$250 winner's prize, a championship trophy and a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations, Jenna!

#### **COUREY TAKES RUNNER-UP**

Cassidy Courey, in her 24th match play appearance, grabbed runner-up honors, and the accompanying \$150 scholarship. The Brooklyn, Minnesota native surged into the runner-up spot by tossing a 10th frame turkey to earn that finish by just 3 pins. Courey was one of 3 past champions appearing in this month's girl's finals field.

#### **JAROS TAKES 3rd**

Hannah Jaros returned to the match play finals for the 2nd consecutive event. The talented right-hander from Yorkville, Illinois finished in 3rd place, earning a \$130 scholarship for her day's work.

#### SWANK SECURES BOWLER OF THE YEAR HONORS WITH 4th PLACE FINISH

Christin Swank was this month's 4th place finisher, and she earned a \$120 scholarship in the process. The 5-time champion was appearing in her 25th match play finals, and by qualifying for the finals, the Muscatine, lowa resident locked up her 2nd Bowler of the Year title; she also captured the award in the 2016-2017 season.

#### **MADISON PLACES 5th**

Brynna Madison finished in 5th place at this month's tour stop. The slender right-hander from Lincoln, Nebraska was returning to the finals for the 2nd time in her promising career, and she hauled away a \$110 scholarship by virtue of her performance.

#### 4-TIME CHAMP HESS PLACES 6th

4-time champion Megan Hess rounded out this month's girl's finals field. The right-hander from Granger, lowa earned a \$100 scholarship for her 6th place finish; this was the 13th finals appearance of her tour career.

Whittney Morse fired a 256 to take home the \$55 scholarship for having high game out of the money.
