The Faith Vision Board

The Faith Vision Team presented this board at a recent congregational meeting. This is the first of the three vision boards presented at that meeting.

Team leader, Kirk Drummond, opened the team's presentation by bringing the whole Faith team to the front.

He introduced the first acronym they created for faith – **For All Is Through Him**. The quotes and images on the left side of the board illustrate this statement of faith.

Kirk also mentioned the verse that "Faith comes from hearing the Word of God." After this verse, each team member read a number of powerful scriptures that supported our faith. All the references and pictures that went with the verses are on the board.

Kirk then introduced the second acronym for faith that the team developed, which is on the right side of the board, Forever Acting In Trusting Him.

This side of the board represents the vision for some of the ministries in the church with regard to faith.


One quote Kirk pointed out specifically says "If we don't teach our children to follow Christ, the world will teach them not to."



This is a test given to students across the nation in both public and private schools. It is exciting each year to see our students' scores, and we have a tangible way of documenting their progress.

As we approach May, we still have a few openings in some classes. Over the past several years we have consistently tracked how parents find our school and found it is by word of mouth - a friend tells a friend and the internet.
