April 4, 2023 Meeting came to order at 7:04pm

Minutes from previous meeting were reviewed some spelling mistakes were noted. Shelley cook gave the motion to approve and Dave Grveles seconded Motion carried.

Public comment: There was no public comment..

Discussed Breaking the Code meetings coming up with those being interested in going talked about with John Tow and will be brought up with the main board. Shelley Cook, Laurie Deater and Donald Maxson were all interested..

Commercial solar arrays were next addressed by the board. There were many different approaches addressed. Remediation and contamination were some of the concerns addressed. Donald Maxson will address MTA to talk about bond issues concerning these arrays. When asking the public for input about the subject Chuck Cargill spoke against the matter mostly with remediation being his concerns..

Next addressed was accessory Dwellings: There were several concerns addressed as this has been something in the past that had caused concern.. The public also addressed the issue as Joe Wozniak and Chuck Cargill both spoke in favor of some allowance of accessory dwellings.. This issue was tabled so as to gather more information from the public as well as information from other resources.. The temporary events ordinance was addressed next.
