John 17:20-26

"Jesus prayed: Holy Father, I pray not only for them, but for those who will believe in me through their word."

Jesus knew that his disciples who witnessed his life, death and resurrection; who learned from his actions; and who listened to his teachings, would one day pass away. Other generations would believe in Him through the word of the eye witnesses. Jesus also knew others would only believe the witnesses if their words matched their actions.
