### President's Message

One of our favorite golf shop employees is moving on to bigger and better things. Congratulations to Daniel Petta on his career move to a position involved with the film industry. Daniel, who served as the golf shop manager, was also a member of our club and the reigning club champion.

One of the great things about the game of golf is the opportunity to meet new people and possibly make long lasting friendships. That opportunity is lost when members insist on playing with their set groups. I know of some of the strongest friendships that have come about from random pairings in our men's club events. Considering that seven of our tournaments are partner events it seems a little unreasonable to insist on playing the remaining five with the same members. The insistence on playing with the same friends also leads to other problems. Among the most serious is the potential for a violation of Rule 8 of the Rules of Golf. The temptation to share a peak at the club one just hit or suggest a line play on the putting green is a concern. You can't decide that the rules are different for friends. Remember that a penalty is imposed not only on the player giving advices but also the player asking for advice. Casual games such as "captains" do not allow you to claim a partner during our Tuesday and Saturday skins games or our tournaments unless it is an event specifically designated as a partner event.

In other words...

***Welcome the chance to play with new or unfamiliar players, as a way to help welcome and retain members.***

***In individual events you cannot share advice, even if you have a partner in a side game.***

Our last tournament highlighted an ongoing problem. The last groups in the C and D flights on Butterfield Stage played in 5 hours and 20 minutes. Somehow some of our members have become incredibly slow and taking the enjoyment out of the round for others. This problem has gotten to the point of being intolerable and will be a major topic at our next board meeting. Expect to see some consequences for slow play.

## Tournament News

Well, we tried a new format this time around and while we had 72 players sign up, my recommendation to the board will be to go back to the 2 man Best Ball. Last year we had many more players/teams and, as you all know, the more players, the better for everyone.

Congratulations to the winning teams; Kerian/Lizarraga (109), Waasdorp/Wilson (106), Hughes/Reardon (100), and Rief/Hagleberg (95). To think, I had to talk Mark into playing!

My take on slow play:

- 1) Stay up with the group in front of you.
- 2) If you start with a gap, catch up to the group in front of you.
- 3) If you get behind due to lost ball, etc., catch up with the group in front of you.

My take on Scoring:

- 1) Markers – **Sign the scorecard!**
- 2) Players – yourself, or, at least one of the team members, **sign the scorecard!**
- 3) Mark your gross score only on the line with your name on it. If you need to know the hole where your strokes are, put a dot or two. Do not put net score slashes on this line.
- 4) Use the net total line to tally net scores.

I did DQ a card for not signing. Fortunately for the players it did not change the outcome. Please get in the habit of checking and signing. I do not want to be the one to take you out of a winning position.

The new 2016 tournament schedule is now posted on the website. Our next tournament is the President's cup on February 27th. We moved this tourney back in the month to accommodate team play.

First of all, it is an individual low net tournament, with regular payouts, skins, and closests in 4 flights.

Secondly, this tournament determines the qualifiers and seeding for our annual match play event, the President's Cup. After the tournament, the top 16 in each flight qualify for this single elimination event, with weekly matches for several weeks. Our President's Cup Champion from last year, Kirk Dancses the #1 seed in his flight and will not have to qualify.

If you cannot participate in all the match play, you can still play the monthly tournament, so don't let that scare you off!
