

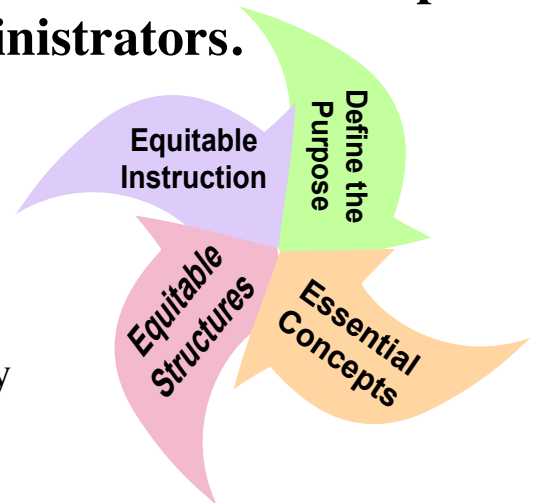

Catalyzing Change: A Step Towards Improving Mathematics Teaching and Learning in Our Schools

Keynote Speaker: Dr. Robert Q. Berry, III
President of NCTM and Professor at the University of Virginia



The National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM) formed three writing teams at the early childhood/elementary, middle school, and high school levels with the intent to initiate the critical conversations needed to address the purposes of school mathematics.

The *Catalyzing Change* series focuses on key recommendations for school mathematics:

- (a) Defining the purpose of school mathematics
- (b) Equitable structures focused on the principles of access, equity, and empowerment
- (c) Equitable instruction focused on NCTM's mathematics teaching framework
- (d) Essential concepts focused on the big mathematical ideas across school mathematics
