Free throw issues...look at a play <u>HERE</u> to see what you have and how you would resume play. Thanks to Chrs Garrita for the clip. BTW...the 'clip' feature on the NFHSNetwork is pretty nice!

Those who were on Craig Bradley's meeting Sunday evening knows the answer to this easily!

In this particular play, white is shooting free throws and black steps into the lane early. We have a delayed violation by the L then the shooter misses the ring entirely! UGH!!!!

Rule 9.1 penalties are on page 60 of the rules book. In addition, when the first violation is by the opponent of the free throw shooter followed by a violation buy the free throw shooter, we cancel this free throw and proceed to an additional free throw(s) OR if it is the last free throw the shooter is entitled to, we go to the AP arrow. Just to add a little more to the mix, if we determine that the violation by the opponent cause a distraction to the free throw shooter, we only penalize the opponent's violation and award a substitute free throw. The case plays for free throw violations/issues are on pages 66-69 of the case book. Make it a point to read rule 9.1 and the associated case plays! You *know* something with free throws will now happen this week!
