**Roussanne Pebble 2012 \$25** Only 10 cases left!

These grapes were picked on two different occasions to achieve the highest quality. A full-bodied white wine with a citrus nose and a lingering mineral finish. Great with chicken, fish or just all by itself.

**Viognier 2013 \$22**

A smooth white wine with the scent of an apple orchard. Apple notes in the taste make this the perfect partner for cheese and fruit trays and hors d'oeuvres at sunset.

**Malbec 2012 \$22 Silver Medal Winner AWGA People's Choice Awards**

Our first lot of Malbec from our California partner vineyard provides the subtle taste of blueberries, tart cherries and the pleasant aroma of toasted oak. As a medium-bodied red wine consider pairing this with soft cheeses, duck or smoked salmon.

**Mourvedre Cobble 2012 \$28**

This well-balanced dry red wine is full bodied and presents subtle hints of white pepper and spice. This intense red wine changes in flavors with each new sip. The smooth finish allows this wine to shine best when served with lamb, steak or anything grilled.

**Petite Sirah 2011 \$22 Kingman Wine Festival 2<sup>nd</sup> Place winner**

A deeply purple colored, full-bodied and fruit-forward red wine featuring a hint of licorice. Riper fruit flavors and higher alcohol. Because of its greater intensity this Petite Sirah is a good match with Italian cooking. Priced so you can drink it with pizza!

**Sandstone 2014**

A blend of our first Riesling harvest and Roussanne this wine showcases green apple notes with a hint of pear.

**Aggregate 2013** (The 2012 sold out fast so don't miss your chance to enjoy the 2013!)

A blend of harvests from our 3-year-old Tempranillo and Petite Sirah blocks. Dry and medium-bodied, this red wine also carries considerable tannins that will allow it to age. Wet-earth aromas and dark fruits.
