“That leaves most armed defenders with two choices: fight or flight. But it’s not always possible to safely retreat, and most people won’t come out of a physical altercation unscathed. There’s a real need for something between a fist fight and a bullet.”

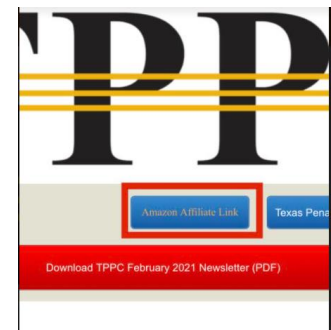
“Firearms instructor Tatiana Whitlock says, “I can’t speak highly enough about pepper spray. We need to embrace that as a gun culture.” She cites T-shirts she’s seen worn at firearms conventions and conferences: “I’m not a pepper spray kind of girl.” Tatiana says the sentiment makes her cringe. “You can afford to make a wrong decision with pepper spray; you can’t make a wrong decision with a bullet.”

“Don West, criminal defense attorney and National Trial Counsel for CCW Safe says he’s never encountered a self-defense case where a defender was charged with a crime for using pepper spray. When someone deploys pepper spray, it’s often used instead of deadly force and is therefore plainly and objectively a reasonable response to a threat. Even if someone was charged with some sort of assault for using pepper spray, the legal defense would be much easier than defending a firearm homicide.”

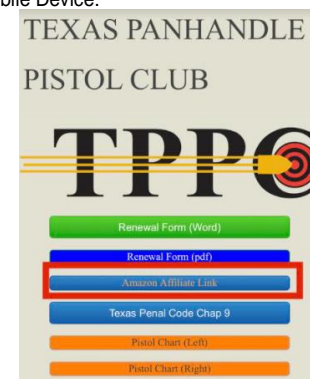

[TX 2nd Amendment Legislation Sign Into Law](#)

Governor Abbot Signed the following legislation into law. Please note these laws do not take effect until September 1, 2021.

Senate Bill 19 prohibits any governmental entity from contracting with any business that discriminates against firearm and ammunition businesses or organizations.

Senate Bill 20 allows guests to store firearms in their hotel rooms.

Senate Bill 550 removes the shoulder or belt holster requirements, allowing Texans to carry firearms in whatever kind of holster they choose.

House Bill 957 repeals the criminal offense of possessing, manufacturing, transporting, or repairing a firearm silencer. It also ensures that any firearm suppressor manufactured in Texas, and that remains in Texas, will not be subject to federal law or federal regulation.

House Bill 1500 prevents any government entity from prohibiting the sale or transportation of firearms or ammunition during a declared disaster or emergency.

House Bill 1927 authorizes Constitutional Carry in Texas, meaning law-abiding Texans can legally carry a handgun without a license to carry.

House Bill 2622 makes Texas a Second Amendment Sanctuary State by protecting Texans from new federal gun control regulations.

Texas Law Shield Present – Texas Constitutional Carry Must-Know Gun Law
