**Coat Give Away** 

This year's Coat Give Away went very well. Thanks to many donations from many churches and individuals, we had more than enough coats, hats, scarfs, gloves, hoodies, and jackets to give away. We hosted the event at The Learning Center to accommodate the larger crowd. Hosting the event at The Learning Center also gave community an opportunity to see the inside of the build. Many had not been inside the facility since Malony's was open; Malony's closed in the mid-80's.

Over 1,500 coats, 800 scars, gloves, and hats were donated. During the week of the give-away, we had mission teams here helping us continue the weekly ministry and prepare for Saturday's event. At 10AM, the line started to form; the line extended from the outside door of the worship area all the way to in front of child protective services. At 2PM, the doors opened. Twenty people were greeted by a "personal shopper" to help select and size coats. Socks, hoodies, scars, and other winter wear were also given away. As each person moved through the building, they were not only showed the love of Christ, they heard the Gospel message. Almost four hundred individuals received coats. Two weeks later, Crossroads passed along coats to the school for their give-away. There is no reason for anyone to go cold this

winter in McCreary County.

We are still raising money for the left station to complete the bathrooms in the Mission Housing @ The Learning Center. The project exceeds \$9,000.

This school year, we are open five days a week for After School @ The Learning Center. We have a few returning students from the previous school year, and many new faces. We average twenty five students each day. Our primary focus is homework packets, math enrichment, and writing skills. Many of the students have seen real improvement in their grades. Each day begins with a little free time and then focus on the Word in devotion. Following devotion, a healthy snack is provided through the Walmart donation.

As important as the educational enrichment is time and love given to each student. Of the twenty five students attending, only two students live with both their mom and dad. One of the goals for After School @ The Learning Center is to provide families more quality time together without the struggles of schoolwork. These kids are great kids.







Amazing! This year as we began to pray and plan the Thanksgiving Dinner, we believed God was leading us to prepare for nine hundred. It seemed like a crazy high number, but we know our God is a great God and provides. Two weeks before the dinner, we did not have any extra food. By the time of the dinner, all the food was available to prepare 900 dinners. In addition to food needed, we needed volunteers to prepare, serve, and clean up.

On the day of the Thanksgiving Dinner, 950 dinners were served! We had plenty of food, and some left over. We truly serve the same God who provided the fish and loaves to feed the masses. God also provided volunteers from four states representing over fifteen churches. One body of believers working together not only to feed community, but to share the Gospel multiple times. Many seeds were planted! We praise God for such an awesome day!





#### Week Day Lunch

(Monday, Wednesday, & Friday)

God is good! This fall, our average attendance for lunch is about one hundred on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday; this up by over forty from last winter. We have also added more community volunteers. We have about ten Crossroads and community plus staff helping to serve. Walmart donations provide the meat each day. We serve anything from meatloaf to grilled steak to ribs to brisket. Walmart provides food each of the same days we serve. At three o'clock, we reopen for fresh food give-away. New faces come into the café each day; many relationships are being made.

We still need donations for each day's meal. In the come months, we will be starting some more construction projects at The Lord's Café. During the summer, we discovered termites in two locations; we also have to repair some water damage in the dining room. Our parking lot is need of repair and repainting. Please pray that God will provide the

resources to get these projects completed.




