Bring your Wyoming Driver's License with you or call the County Clerk's office to learn what other identification is acceptable. Provisional ballots will be available at the polls.

INFORMATION FOR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES

Currently in Weston County all polling places are accessible to persons with limited mobility. There will also be at least one (1) ExpressVote® Universal Voting System at every polling location. This allows a person with a disability to mark their ballot with little or no assistance whether they have a visual or dexterity disability and they place their ballot in the DS200 for tabulation. According to Wyoming Statute 22-13-113(a) "... any elector who requires assistance to vote because of blindness, disability or inability to read or write may be given assistance by a person of the elector's choice, other than the elector's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of the elector's union.
