Provide financial support for the costs to educate our students






2023 – 2024 HSA Profit Goal = \$55,000

We do not expect every family to SPEND on fundraisers, but everyone can still be part of the team effort and SHARE our fundraiser LINKS in support of the overall goal.





SALES FUNDRAISER




DATES: October 2 – October 23 Materials will be sent home mid-September!
