

#### "Good Friday, Easter and God's Grace"

"...Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and... He was buried, and... He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures..." 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

Sin is complicated. There are a variety of Hebrew words in the Old Testament and Greek words in the New Testament that are translated as "sin" in our English Bibles. In the Old Testament the two most common words are *chata* and *avon*. *Chata* has an original idea of "to miss the mark." In dealing with a holy and righteous God, we humans always have a problem of missing the mark. *Avon* has a suspected original idea of "to bend, twist, distort." We humans also have a tendency to bend, twist and distort God's truth, God's commands and God's principles.

There are other words that are used in the Old Testament to describe unrighteousness. One Hebrew scholar says that there are 24 different Hebrew words that are translated as "unrighteousness." Then also there are specific wrongdoings that are described, such as those that are listed in the Ten Commandments. The Law of Moses has what seem to most of us rather complicated instructions about how to deal with sin. There are sin offerings and separate guilt offerings that involve animal sacrifice. There are also laws that deal with restitution that is necessary to deal with sins that involve people who have been the object of wrongdoing.

In the New Testament there is *hamartia*, which means "to err, or "miss the mark." It is used to describe offenses against morals, laws, men or gods. *Adikia* is usually translated as "unrighteousness." *Parabasis* is used to describe transgression of the law of God. *Paraptoma*, which literally means "to fall down beside," is used to refer to moral lapses. There is also *anomia*, for lawlessness, and *asebeia*, for godlessness. Of course we also find specific sins listed in the New Testament. Sin also involves thoughts, words and deeds. It includes the failure to accomplish certain deeds.

In stark contrast to all of this is grace. In the Old Testament there is only one word for "grace." It is *chen*. It means "grace." I noted in a recent sermon that the high priest Annas had a name based on this work. He was anything but gracious. According to one scholar, the verb form describes "an action from a superior to an inferior who has no real claim for gracious treatment."

In the New Testament there is likewise only one word for "grace." It is *charis*, from which is derived *charismata*, or "spiritual gifts," which we are gifts of grace. The term appears 155 times in the New Testament. Grace is central to the resolution of the sin problem. It is the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ that is the ultimate demonstration of grace. Thus the New Testament tells us, "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God..." (Ephesians 2:8) "[We are] justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus..." (Romans 3:24)

Grace is not only central to how we come into a relationship with God. It is also foundational to our ongoing relationship with God. This is the message of the Book of Galatians. It is also seen in Romans 5:2: "...[we have been introduced] by faith into this grace in which we stand..." All of this is based on God's grace shown to us in the death and resurrection of Jesus. Thank God for His grace. - Pastor Kurt

Our next Care Center & Hospital Long Term Area Visit will be on Saturday, the 6th. Meet at 9:45 AM.






