ORDINANCE NO. 413 -- LOITERING ABROAD

An ordinance prohibiting loitering between 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. in the City of Rolla, and providing penalties for violation.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolla, North Dakota;

- 1. <u>LOITERING PROHIBITING</u> It shall be unlawful in the City of Rolla or within its jurisdiction to loiter, loaf, wander, stand or remain idle in any place without a demonstrable, lawful reason, or on the highways, public streets or alleys, or on railway rights-of-way or other rights-of-way, or on parking lots, or on public grounds, between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. of any day, in such a manner so as to obstruct, hinder or impede the free and uninterrupted passage of vehicle traffic or pedestrians, or to interfere with the free and uninterrupted ingress, egress, regress, therein, thereon, and thereto. Such loitering is hereby declared to be a nuisance and shall include loitering in vehicles as well as pedestrian loitering.
- 2. <u>POLICE ORDER TO DISPERSE</u> When any person causes or commits any of the conditions enumerated in section 1, a police officer or any law enforcement officer shall order that person to stop committing such conditions and to move on or disperse. Any person who fails or refuses to obey such orders shall be guilty of a violation of this article.
- **3. PENALTIES** Any person guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court; The Court to have power to suspend said sentence and to revoke the suspension thereof.
