2021 GRANTS AWARDED




MSS (Midwest Special Services) has bees at their Shoreview center with accessible tilting stands for the hives. This makes it easier for people in wheelchairs or with other physical limitations to interact with the bees. They have also designed and made bee suits to go over various types of wheelchairs so people won't have to be moved out of their chairs to suit up.

Northeast Youth and Family Services

Laptops were made available to NETS Day Treatment clients so that they were able to maintain a continuity of care through COVID. NYFS was able to use technology to allow clients to safely participate in group and individual therapy through COVID stay-at-home orders and self-isolation. The laptops removed a barrier to care. The laptops will continue to be of service to NYFS as cohorts of youth will be able to work together to access community resources, resume building, continuing education, and work-force training.

Shoreview Historical Society is updating, printing, and distributing a historical booklet with self-guided tour.



Mounds View Schools

Offered EmpowerU, a personalized, social-emotional learning program to high school students.



Ramsey County Library in Shoreview and the Shoreview Bikes and Trails Committee will use their grant for four bicycle repair stations, bike repair, and safety clinics and videos.

Currently, only one station has been installed (at the library) due to supply chain issues and weather.

Application timeline for 2023 grants will be announced in the Fall.

The independent volunteer Board selects grant recipients based on established criteria and is responsible for leadership and fundraising.
