



2023 Reserved Pit Spot Information

GUIDELINES

- ✓ Having a reserved pit spot is NOT required to race at the Speedrome. There is plenty of open parking in the back gravel area west of the tech shack. Also, some of the reserved spots may be available on the various nights that a driver's division is not in action. Track may assign teams to those spots on occasion. Track decisions are final on ALL pit spot situations.
- ✓ If you are racing a half season or less, getting a reserved pit spot is not generally necessary. Spots that are only used a handful of times take away spots for teams interested in running all year. This includes Late Model Figure 8 teams that only plan on running the "big shows", we will find you a place to park.
- ✓ Those who get a reserved pit spot and miss 3 straight events for your division CAN lose that spot for the remainder of the year WITHOUT refund.
- ✓ Out of town Late Model Figure 8 teams, contact Scott during the week that you are racing with us. He will find you a spot to park in for that event.
- ✓ The sharing of spots is encouraged when possible. Look over the schedule.
- ✓ Reserved pit parking spots are again \$200 each for 2023.

CHOOSING OF PIT SPOTS

- PHASE 1 – Late Model Figure 8. These will be handled on a one on one basis with teams beginning in order of last years point standings.
- PHASE 2 – Perfect Show drivers from 2022 in the non-Late Model divisions. This phase will begin Saturday March 18th no later than 4pm in the pit office. The line for these folks can begin forming outside NO EARLIER THAN 3:30pm.
- PHASE 3 – Remaining interested drivers. This phase will begin Saturday March 25th no later than 4pm in the pit office. The line for these folks can begin forming outside NO EARLIER THAN 3:30pm.
