1. Follow the DNR fishery biologist recommendations for no spraying in the two prime lake fish spawning areas of Calico Bay along Monroe Road, and the delta area in front of the Pentwater River outlet.
2. Encourage native shoreline vegetation for maintaining fish fingerling habitat.
3. Reduce blue-green and filamentous algae growth to prevent algae blooms.
4. Better control of hybrid Eurasian water milfoil by reducing it to stands of less than 20% by density. We accept the fact we cannot eliminate it all.
5. Reduce organic muck buildup in the shoreline areas. This reduces the nutrient load available for aquatic invasive plants and algae to use to grow.
6. Eliminate dense stands of starry stonewort and cabomba.
7. All floating mats of aquatic plants/algae shall be treated by nonchemical means.
8. Provide an annual evaluation of the lake manager. The annual evaluation is based on the annual goals and the performance contract for the lake manager.
