## ***BRUMBY YEARLING CHALLENGE in association with Victorian Brumby Association and Australian Brumby Challenge***

### **BRUMBY YEARLING CHALLENGE 2019 INFORMATION**

Welcome to the **Brumby Yearling Challenge** event! This event is devised to support the work of the Victorian Brumby Association to spread the message about how terrific Brumbies are and to help find them great homes.

All Brumbies in the **Brumby Yearling Challenge** event were either born or conceived in the wild. They have all been gelded and had appropriate vet treatment (microchips, worming etc), but are completely unhandled. Minimum required fencing is 5', of post and rail construction. We have three classes for this event – Junior, for trainers aged 10 – 17 years (supported by a mentor/ supervisor), Adult, for trainers aged 18 years plus and a Team class for Juniors who attend a recognised riding school or club and don't own their own horses. Teams will consist of three, will have one mentor/ supervisor and each junior must show the yearling Brumby in one of the finals classes.

The **Brumby Yearling Challenge** will commence with **pickup at our Brumby Junction Sanctuary** in Glenlogie Victoria on Saturday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August, 2019, approved trainers will take their nominated Brumby home for 99 days, **returning to the Brumby Festival in the Yarra Valley** on Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup> of November, 2019 for three finals classes.

**Applications open on Monday the 8<sup>th</sup> of July 2019.**

**Applications close on Friday the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2019.**

All Brumbies remain the under the ownership of the Victorian Brumby Association throughout the event. The **application fee of \$150** may be fully offset against the purchase of the Brumby at the end of the event, should the trainer wish to purchase them. Brumbies trained through this program are available to their trainers to purchase for \$750 at the completion of the event (less the \$150 entrance fee). Those Brumbies not purchased by their trainers at the completion of the event will return to the Brumby Junction Sanctuary until they too find their forever homes.

The finals event classes will be held at the Brumby Festival in the Yarra Valley on Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup> of November, 2019. There will be three compulsory classes:

- Leadline and conditioning
- Obstacles class
- Freestyle class (3 minutes to music of your choice)

Those competing in the Teams event, each trainer must take the yearling in one class.

We have only limited spaces in this first ever event, so regret that even if you are highly qualified to undertake this event, we may not be able to provide you with a yearling.

*Participation in this event is by invitation only; therefore, the Committee of the Victorian Brumby Association has the unqualified right to determine eligibility and can, at any time, remove a contestant from the Australian Brumby Challenge and/or competition for any or no reason at all.*



## **BRUMBY YEARLING CHALLENGE 2019: HUMANE TREATMENT POLICY**

Every Brumby and all animals shall, at all times, be treated humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Any participant using abusive or excessive training techniques or being inhumane to a Brumby in his/her care (determined excessive or abusive by a panel assigned by the Victorian Brumby Association and consisting of licensed equine veterinarian(s) and/or respected horse industry professionals) may be removed from the contest and/or all future contests and training programs. If a participant's horse enters the contest or if the trainer/participant at any time presents a horse with questionable training/care related injuries (determined excessive or abusive by a panel assigned by the Victorian Brumby Association and consisting of licensed equine veterinarian(s) and/or respected horse industry professionals) the participant may be removed from the contest and/or all future contests and training programs.

The following list includes but is not limited to examples of unacceptable behaviour and training techniques:

- No horse appearing to be emaciated, drawn or injured may be exhibited.
- Use of or evidence of inhumane training techniques or methods such as striking horse with objects, excessive spurring and/or excessive jerking of reins.
- Any inhumane treatment.

Additionally, the Victorian Brumby Association and Australian Brumby Challenge promote and encourages the following examples of sound, compassionate, and successful training techniques and Brumby handling methods:

- Horse and trainer exhibiting solid relationship based on respect and understanding
- A calm and willing partnership between horse and trainer, regardless of the obstacle or environmental challenge during competition or training phases
- Trainer maintains a credible level of dignity for the horse during all phases of training and competition.
- Trainers are expected to seek and employ methods of horsemanship in order to promote and encourage the positive relationship between horse and trainer.
- Training techniques should demonstrate a strong bond between horse and trainer

The Victorian Brumby Association and Australian Brumby Challenge support the highest attention to humane treatment and welfare in equine competitions of all kind and are committed to supporting the International Society for Equine Sciences Code of Conduct (attached to this application form). My signature below indicates that I have read, understood and fully support this document.

Through my signature below, I certify that I have read and understand the Victorian Brumby Association and Australian Brumby Challenge Humane Treatment policy, and agree to abide by these principles as a participant in the Australian Brumby Challenge program.
