## Four-Part Educational Series

The Transformative Leadership Academy for Person-Centered Care is a four-part series from January to July, 2015. The Academy will focus on changing aging services from a healthcare institutional model to a person-centered (directed) model, while increasing the organization's ability to meet regulatory and efficiency goals more effectively. The cost of the entire Leadership Academy is \$200.

TLA is looking for new and emerging leaders as well as innovative and seasoned leaders. It is designed for people that are committed to making change with demonstrated effective leadership qualities. Applicants should be strong decision makers and leaders with authority and drive. The academy is limited to 30 participants. Successful applicants will be chosen by a panel based on application essays and reference letters.
