

## **Genealogical Notes On John Hindall (Jr) and his wife Catherine:**

**BACKGROUND:** This research activity is focused on the eldest son of John and Mary Hindall who lived on land leased from John Blackwell (as specified in the lease - for the duration of their lives) within the county of Fauquier, the state of Virginia. After the death of John Hindall (no record found of Mary's death) in 1829, it appears that most (within John's will there are three daughters mentioned that I have been (so far) unable to find additional records) and John and Mary's children (except Susan who married into the Dodd family) migrated out of Virginia. Two daughters married McLearen brothers and moved to Illinois as did the middle son William who was a circuit rider (preacher) for the Methodist church. Youngest son Robert, moved to Licking County, Ohio and Eldest son John (Jr) moved to Logan County, Ohio.

**OBJECTIVE:** To discover and document the descendants of John and Catherine Hindall, who were the eldest son and daughter-in-law of the family progenitor John Hindall (Sr) and his wife Mary.

**GOAL:** Discover the names of John and Catherine's children and then trace their family history.

**DISCUSSION:** When John and Catherine were listed in the 1840 census they had moved from Fauquier County, VA to Perry Township, Logan County Ohio; they have three daughters and two sons – five children's names to discover.

**NOTE:** Variation in the spelling of the last name –Hindall -- has been observed in some (possible) records, with the spellings being "Hindle or Hendl..

Possible Sons & Daughters of John & Catherine:

There is a grave and a name, Thomas Hindall on grave marker and his name is mentioned as being a husband on two other graves. It appears Thomas Hindall was first married to Mary Raley who died in 1855, and then it appears Thomas married another sister name Phoebe Raley. Also, it is possible that "Thomas" is a middle name and "William" is the first name of this individual.

Potential Eldest Son and Possibly a Daughter: In the 1850 census appears the name of John Hindle, age 20, born in 1830 in Virginia. He appears in the household of James Boyd (23 yrs old) and Elizabeth (19 yrs old) located in Monroe Twp, Logan Co, Ohio. Why does John appear in this household? Could Elizabeth be a sister?

In the 1860 census a John Hendel (note the spelling of the name), age 30, born in 1830, in Virginia appears as a head of household located in Washington Twp, Morrow Co, Ohio. He appears to be married to Mariah and they have a one year old daughter.

Hindall, John, 9 Mar 1796-20 Aug 1871 (husband of Catherine Hindall; father of Mary A. Hindall)

Hindall, Mary A., 8 Dec 1834-19 Sep 1909 (daughter of John & Catherine Hindall)

Hindall, Phoebe T., 5 Feb 1834-19 Nov 1902 (wife of Thomas Hindall)

Hindall, Thomas, 5 Dec 1824-6 Sep 1896 (husband of Phoebe T. Hindall)

Hindle, Catharine E., d 19 Aug 1855, ae -m 11d (daughter of T. & Mary Hindle; partly illegible)

Hindle, Harley Arron, d 2 Jul 1876 (son of T. & P. Hindle)

Hindle, Mary, d 22 May 1855, ae 23y 5m 20d (wife of Tho's Hindle)
