The I/T Teacher plans and implements developmentally appropriate learning experiences in the Early Head Start Center. Candidates would coordinate the classroom including daily activities with kids, paperwork and parent communication. The I/T Teacher is also required to promote a positive, happy and nurturing learning environment including children with disabilities and dual language learners. Candidates must be able to demonstrate effective communication and a non-judgmental attitude when working with staff, families and children. This position is full time year round. Prefer someone with the ability to speak Spanish and English but not required.
