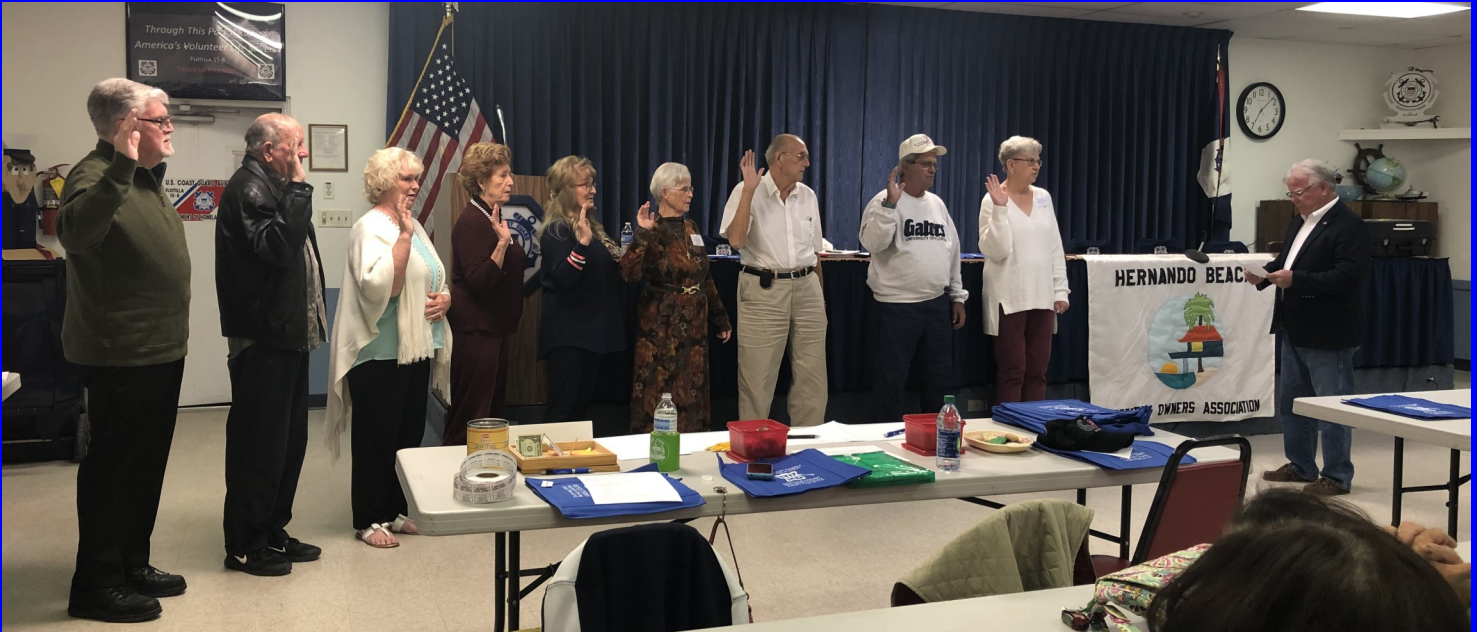

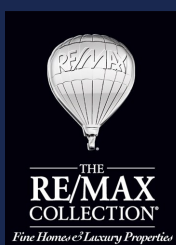

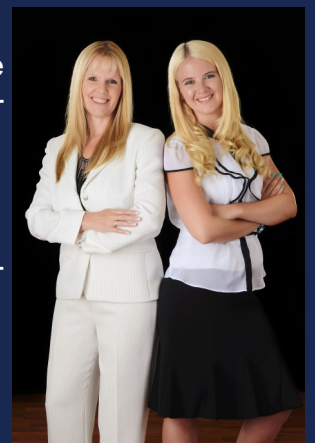

## MINUTES OF HBPOA MEETING, COAST GUARD BUILDING January 10, 2019, @ 7:00 PM

The first meeting for the New Year of Hernando Beach Property Owners' Association was called to order at 7:10 PM by Kathy Frase, President, who led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Kathy then invited Wayne Dukes, Dist. 2 County Commissioner to install our slate of officers for this calendar year: Kathy Frase, Pres; Benny Martinez, V-Pres; Bud Frase, Treasurer; Pat Cordova, Rec. Sec; Fran Baird, Director; Joy Martinez, Director; Toby Wightman, Director; Joe Wachs, Director; and Gladys Moore, Past Pres. Director. Wayne asked all board members to come forward and installed us as a group.

Benny Martinez presented a check for \$400 to Noreen St. Jean, Director of Development for the Hernando County Boys and Girls Club to be used to assist in their many services to the children of HC who need and benefit from them. Currently the local program serves over 1800 children. Noreen went into a lot of detail about all the services that are provided and the impact that this has on the boys and girls in our county who benefit from their various programs. She also pointed out that of the moneys that are given to the Boys and Girls Club, 88% of the donations go directly to services for the children. Kathy informed us that from the moneys that were raised from raffles at the Christmas party and also the Crafts Fair at the Fire Department before Christmas, we also donated \$200 to the firemen's charity, Operation Heartfelt.

Our guest speaker was next introduced by Benny: Carmen Bruno, the Recycling Coordinator for the Department of Solid Waste and Recycling of Hernando County. Mr. Bruno came in pulling a large garbage container, one of thousands that are being distributed by Republic Services over the next few weeks. This particular container will be used in conjunction with mechanized trucks that will pick it up and empty the contents, hands free. This will allow the new trucks to be manned by only one person. He explained the proper way to have the container waiting at the curbside on trash day and emphasized

sized that as of Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>, only garbage that is in the container will be picked up. He further explained that our trash pickup will remain the same as it is now except that the actual pickup days may shift. It was interesting to hear about our county landfill, size, location, etc., as well as some innovative ways they are managing it, some of which have been pioneering.

Mr. Bruno next addressed the issue of recycling, encouraging everyone to recycle. He stated that we will continue to use the recycling bins using the same criteria for how and what we recycle. He explained some of the issues involved in what is accepted for recycling.

A number of questions were entertained and answered by our speaker, most of which added more detail and understanding of the program. He also informed us that there are going to be opportunities to tour the county landfill location and these will be publicized on the website. Besides the obvious reasons for taking advantage of this opportunity to learn more about their operation, he enticed us with descriptions of the vari-

ous birds and animals that can be found there and also the incredible views that one may experience there. All in all, his presentation was very informative as well as entertaining!

Kathy thanked our speaker for his presentation and then asked for a motion to accept the minutes as presented in the Beachcomber. Benny Martinez's motion was seconded by Joy Martinez and the motion passed.

Bud Frase gave the Treasurer's Report as follows: Balance on hand as of Nov. 1, 2018 was \$20,273.89 and on Dec. 31, 2018 was \$27,166.52. The report will be filed for audit.

#### REPORTS:

Landscaping....Gladys Moore happily reported that there have been no accidents recently at either the Triangle or at Hwy. 19 site. There will be weeding this Sat at 10 AM at the Triangle and any kind volunteer who would like to help will make the task much easier! Gladys also stated that she and Fran Baird and another volunteer are going to be consulting with a local nursery to explore how some of the area could be replanted

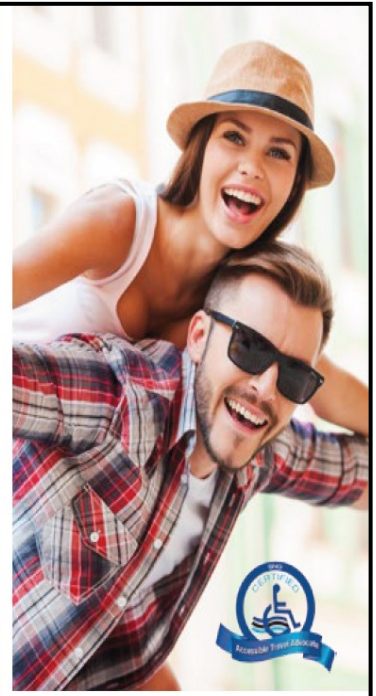

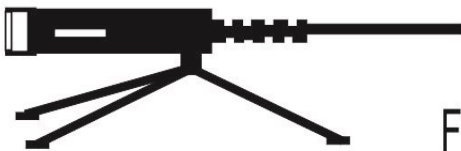

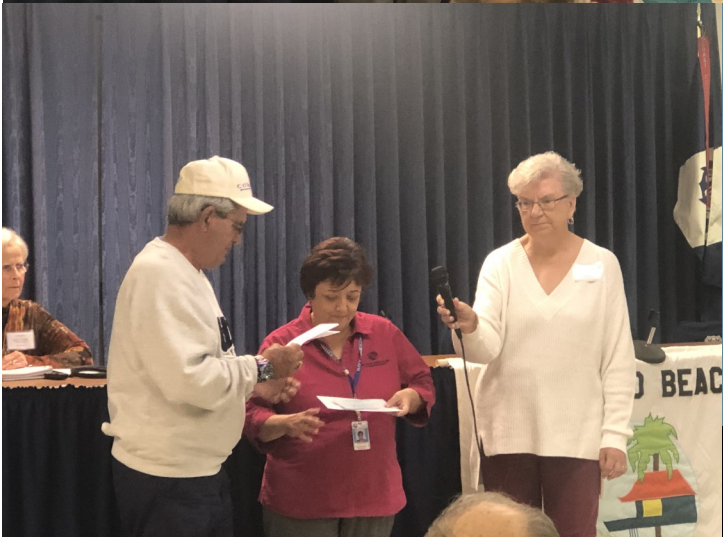

## RECYCLING PICK-UP

Hernando County citizens with trash service also have weekly curbside recycling collection included in their service. Curbside recycling is collected with a two bin system where residents sort cardboard and paper in one bin and plastics #1-7, aluminum and tin in a second bin. Please note that our curbside program does not include glass. These bins are then picked up by our contractor and delivered to the Northwest Waste Management Facility. The material is then further sorted and prepared for shipment to various locations by a contractor.

If you currently subscribe to curbside trash service through Republic Services, once per week curbside Recycling is included in your service **at no additional cost.**

**To get started** with curbside recycling please call Republic Services at (352) 540-6457 to have your *freebins* delivered and determine your recycling pickup day.

**On your pickup day**, place all of your paper and cardboard in one container and aluminum, tin, and plastics in the second container. Place the containers curbside before 6 a.m. on your service day.

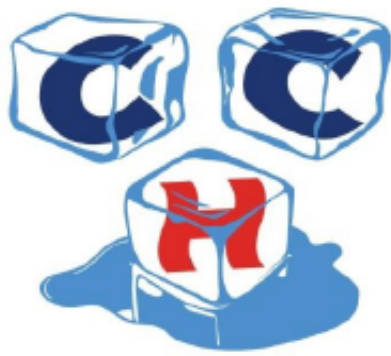

- equivalent of yard waste, per pickup. (Trash collection is limited to a total of three containers)
- For larger quantities contact Republic Services in advance. An additional fee will apply
  - Containers and bags, including content, shall be a maximum of 45 gallons in size and not to exceed fifty pounds each
  - Bundled yard waste is limited to bundles not in excess of fifty pounds and four feet in length
  - Branches/limbs cannot exceed four inches in diameter or four feet in length
  - Live Christmas trees may be disposed of on your regularly scheduled yard waste day if trees are cut to under 4 foot lengths & cleaned of all decorations, including tinsel
  - Customers shall set out containers of yard waste no later than 6 a.m. on the designated collection day and no earlier than 6 p.m. the day prior to the designated collection day

- Customers shall set out yard waste within six feet or as near to the roadway abutting the customer's property as safely possible
- Although every effort is made to keep areas clean of spilled yard waste, some spillage may occur when transferring loose yard waste from the container to the truck

## Alternative Disposal Options

- Hernando County Residents may take their own yard waste to one of our three locations for disposal
- Residents may dispose of a combined total of up to 2,000 lbs of all types of solid waste per year for free
- It is a violation of Hernando County Ordinance to dump yard waste or other waste on any vacant property, private property or public rights of way
- Commercial businesses are required to take waste to the Northwest Landfill and be charged the appropriate tipping fee for disposal

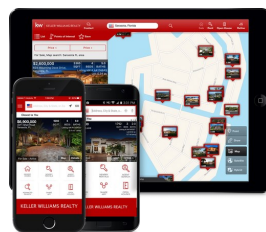

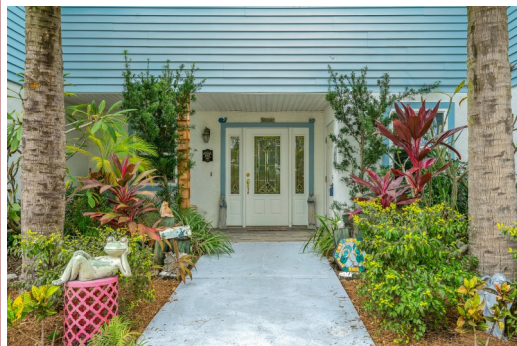
