The 2018 Football World Cup – France is Champion!!!

Congratulations to the French national football team for beating Croatia 4 to 2 at the FIFA world cup finals in Moscow, July 15. This is the second world cup championship for France, the last being in 1998. The French team has been heralded as one of the youngest and most diverse in history. The celebrations throughout France, most notably on the Champs Elysees and throughout Paris, were also among the largest and wildest in a long time. Well deserved!

A few other notes:

The **2018 Tour de France** finished on July 29. Sporting history was made on the Champs-Elysees Sunday as Geraint Thomas became the first Welshman to win cycling's Tour de France. Congratulations also to the French, Julian Alaphilippe, for being the best climber of the Tour!

Back to School - Although much less publicized, but of similar importance – our 2018 – 2019 French classes for Kids and Teens will begin on August 27.
