FREE Legal Advice!! Learn what you legally CAN and CANNOT do as a landlord!!!!!

- Your tenant has obtained custody of his 4 grandchildren and requests to add them to his lease—Most of your tenants are elderly—can you legally deny the request?
- An individual in a wheelchair wants to rent your house that has no handicapped access—Can you refuse to rent to them?
- An individual with a poor rental history wants to rent your apartment—Can you refuse to rent to them?
- You refuse to rent to an applicant based on their appearance—Is this legal?
- Can you ask an applicant about his religious beliefs or his age?
- Can you deny an applicant housing because they have children and you only rent to the elderly?
- Can you require families with children to live in a specific section of the mobile home park?

Attorney Tim Matheson will provide training to attendees and answer your questions pertaining to landlord/tenant law in TN, Reasonable Accommodations of disabilities and Federal Fair Housing Laws.
