

**MEMBERSHIP DUES**

**for**

**GRANT COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.**

**Approved: December 5, 2018**

In accordance with Article IV of the By-laws of the Grant County Chamber of Commerce, Membership Dues are set as detailed below:

1. There shall be five (5) classes of membership, but an applicable class may be changed by the Board of Directors at its discretion. The classes are:

Class I

Banks and other financial institutions (including Branch Offices)  
Beer, soft drink, and all other beverage distributors  
Coal production or other mineral production companies  
Supermarkets and other large national or regional chain stores  
Utilities and utility companies

Class II

Automobile dealers-new vehicles  
Contractors (Incorporated)  
Hospitals and nursing homes  
Insurance agencies  
Petroleum products distributors  
Lumber mills and builders supply companies  
Manufacturers and fabricators-processors  
Motels and hotels  
Professionals, including but not limited to, doctors, dentists, opticians, chiropractors, attorneys, and accountants  
Real estate businesses  
Retail stores or retail businesses with six (6) or more employees  
Small and medium size chain stores  
Wholesale hardware businesses  
Wholesale businesses not otherwise named

Class III

Automobile dealers-used vehicles  
Individual Insurance agents  
Retail stores and retail businesses with less than six (6) employees  
Service businesses, such as, but not limited to, electricians, dry cleaners, plumbing and heating, automobile service stations, and bed & breakfast  
Restaurants  
Any business not otherwise named

Class IV

Small home-based businesses, such as home party Consultants, beauty consultants, hair salons, etc. Persons not currently actively engaged in a business enterprise, but who have prior business knowledge and experience, such as but not limited to retirees Agriculture (Farm Related)

Class V (Non-Voting Membership, Non-Board Member Non-Officer)

"Friends of the Chamber" who are persons not currently actively engaged in a business enterprise, and/or with no prior business knowledge or experience Government agencies-all non-profits, non-Governmental groups, organizations, civic clubs and other related bodies

2. Dues shall be based on the anniversary date of membership and shall be paid in advance in one (1) payment. Members will be billed by the Chamber for any and all new or renewal dues or due balances.

(a)	Class I annual dues	\$310.00
	Class II annual dues	\$160.00
	Class III annual dues	\$ 85.00
	Class IV annual dues	\$ 60.00
	Class V annual dues	\$ 35.00

(b) Individuals with multiple businesses, with the exact ownership structure, will pay regular dues fee assessed to their highest-class business and \$25.00 for each additional business (non-voting membership).
