1.0 Approval of Minutes

- 1.1 A motion was made to approve the August Interim Board Minutes, with one amendment. The motion was approved.
- 1.2 A motion was made to approve the September Interim Board Minutes. The motion was approved.

2.0 2019 Board Elections

3.0 CERT Update

- 3.1 Jim Williams reported on the status of Branch 1 & 2 CERT:
 - 3.1.1 225 CERTS and Hams are in the queue; 96 CERTS, 45 Hams and 58 in the training cycle. There will be 30 additional CERTS trained by the end of the year and another 30 by the end of February 2019. The 1^{st} Unit of CERT training includes 1 ½ hours on radios.
- 3.2 Jim reiterated that he does not intend to stay in the CERT leadership role and that he would like volunteers to take over Branch 1 and Branch 2 CERT leadership. The Board will ask for volunteers at the General Meeting on October 22.

4.0 Bylaw changes

4.1 Two revisions were recommended to the bylaws: (1) allow up to 9 board members and (2) moved Red Cross from the list of Standing Committees to the Advisory Committee. A motion was made and approved for the revisions.

5.0 Newsletter

5.1 Jeneen requested and has received submissions from the Advisory Board for the next issue of the newsletter.

6.0 General Meeting Agenda – Monday, October 22 at the Half Moon Bay Fire House.

6.1 Agenda items include: board election results, new Shelter Ops Standing Committee, update on Branch 1 / 2 CERT – interest in leadership, a presentation by Chief Ari Delay on wildfires, and presentation by Patrick McGee on working in an ops center at some of the recent big fires.

7.0 Simulated Emergency Test (SET) Updates

- 7.1 The SET for Branch 3 and 4 is on Saturday, October 20 and will include activation of Southcoast CERT, South Skyline CERT, San Mateo County Large Animal Evac and the landing of a Stanford Lifeflight helicopter at a new landing zone in Castanea Ridge. The staging area is at Skyline Ridge Preserve. Plans include: the mobile ham resource trailer will serve as the DOC; five neighborhoods will conduct welfare checks; CERT damage assessments in those neighborhoods; six horses will be evacuated; the new SSEPO medical mobile unit will be on display.
- 7.2 The SET for Branch 1 and 2 has been postponed to next year.
