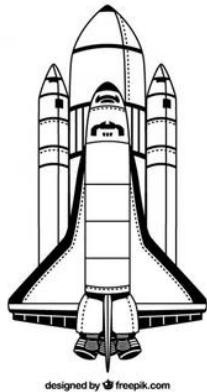

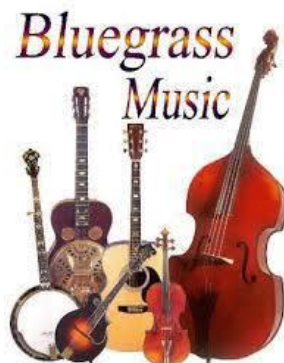

21x28in Main Fabric for body

(2) 4x14in Main Fabric for handles

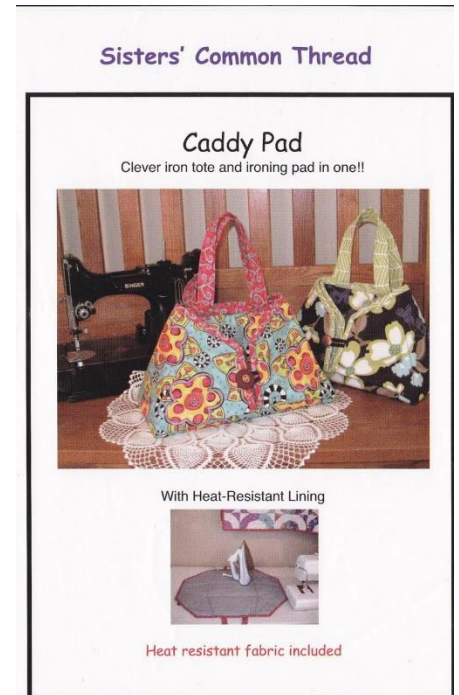
21x28in heat resistant ironing board fabric

(2) 21x28in layers of insul bright or cotton batting or 1 layer of warm tater

(2) 1" or larger pretty buttons (shank buttons work well)

9in 1/4in wide elastic

1/4 yard contrast fabric to make about 90in of binding

Supplies:

To Make Table Runner 42 5x5in squares

1 yard white solid for blocks

1/2yard red check for binding

1 1/2yards fabric for backing

**OR to Make One Plate**

18 5x5in squares

15x15in white background

**double wide 4 patch Dresden template available at quilts and lace or online.**

\*Usual sewing supplies – Iron, cutter, mat, machine, thread and

Sew 42 5x5in squares into 7 rows of 6 squares each
