#### Newcomers Guest Policy

There has been some confusion recently regarding guest attendance at our luncheons and our events. Our board recently voted to clarify our guest policy as follows:

A guest is any prospective member of the club who **has never before** been a member. Guests may attend two events of their choice. After that, they must join the club before attending any additional events. If a person has already been a member, they cannot come to a luncheon or interest group meeting without rejoining the club and paying the full-year cost of current annual dues. The only exception is for visitors and former members who have moved out of the Central Florida area. They are welcome to join us without restrictions (per the visitor policy outlined in our by-laws and published in our Directory).

Two of our most popular club events--the Fashion Show and Game Day-are now officially exempt from any limitations on attendance. Everyone (including past members) is welcome to attend either or both of these events as often as they like. Attendance at these events **will not count** toward a guest's lifetime (not annual) two-event limit.

This meeting also gave us the opportunity to evaluate the books we have read over the past year. The top four, not in any particular order were:


