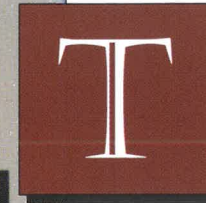
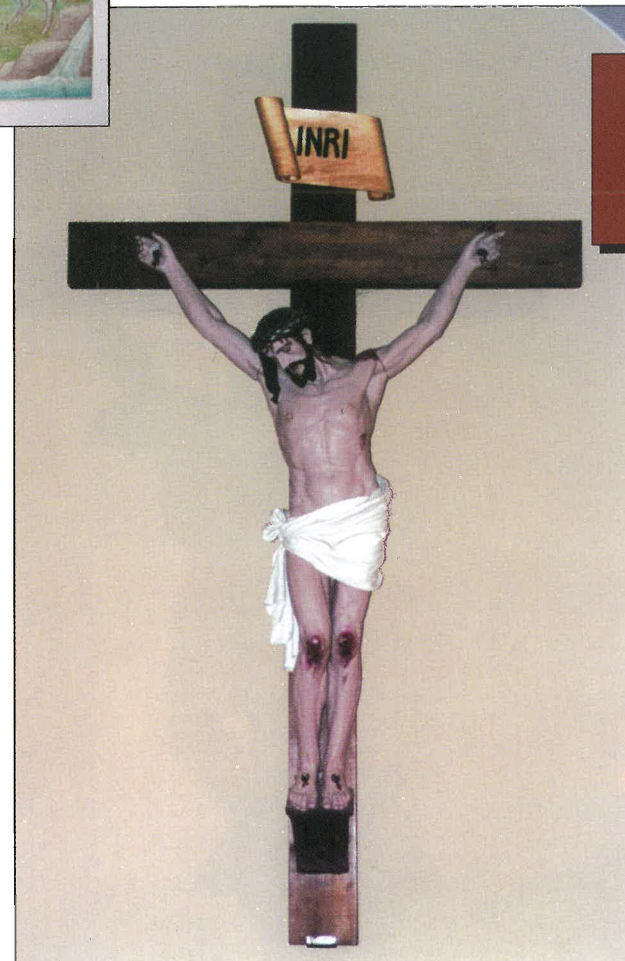


his mural is representative of Abel, the second son of Adam and Eve. Abel became the keeper of the flocks while his older brother, Cain, became a tiller of the soil.

All the elements in the 23rd Psalm are present in this mural; the shepherd, the pasture, the restful waters, the table spread in the presence of my foes, the rod and the staff, and the setting sun casting its shadows across the valley.



he Crucifix reminds us of the saving death of Jesus, who died to free us from the power of sin and death. The

scroll, which was placed on the cross at the orders of Pilate, stated in Greek, Hebrew, and Latin: "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews".

The letters INRI are the initial letters from the Latin: "Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum". (At that time the letter "I" served for both "I" and "J" in Latin.)
