The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires that all schools conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) that may be present in the school environment. AHERA requires the inspection results and the associated Management Plan to be submitted to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ). A copy of the Management Plan must be maintained at the administrative office and available for review by the public.

Maurepas School maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program. Periodic surveillances (every six months) are performed by a qualified individual to assess the condition of the remaining asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). All of this information is updated in the Management Plan and available for review.
