ADVANCED TACTICS & FIREARMS, LLC wishes to announce PERSONAL PROTECTION IN THE HOME course that will be offered to qualified citizens <u>at the AGAWAM REVOLVER CLUB (ARC)</u>, 302 <u>Feeding Hills Road</u>, <u>Southwick</u>, <u>MA 01077</u>, <u>on Friday April 21</u>, 2017. The live fire portion of the course <u>will occur in the indoor range</u>.

The cost will be \$175.00 for non- ARC members, \$150.00 for ARC members. The course will need to have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 16 in order to occur. Anyone who has not registered prior to 4/19/17 and still wish to take the course, will be assessed an additional charge of \$25 from the listed cost.

This classroom/live fire course will teach the basic knowledge, skills and attitude essential to the safe and defensive use of a handgun for protection of self and family members in the home as well as providing information on the law abiding person's right to self-defense. The theme of the course will be the proper and safe handling of handguns while carrying on the person as well as acquiring and developing skillsets to survive an armed encounter. The emphasis of the training will be the defensive use of force with a handgun. The student will learn basic defensive shooting skills; strategies and options for home safety to include avoiding as well as dealing with dangerous confrontations; the law and the aftermath of a self-defense incident with *suggestions*. Are you prepared for the actual defensive use of force as well as protecting your rights? The training will stress consistent and competent firearms presentation.

The majority of the course will be classroom instruction followed by defensive handgun drills that will enhance the shooter's ability to address an armed confrontation in the home. Safety will be stressed during the course content. The live fire portion of the course will end with a handgun qualification course which will allow the instructor cadre to assess individual skillsets as well as provide the shooter the ability to assess his/her progress in the course. Students will be instructed in the proper and safe handling of handguns at all times. The live fire building blocks will be discussed and demonstrated by the cadre. The course will commence promptly at 5pm. The qualification course will incorporate shooting *competition* drills among course participants. Certificates of successful completion of the course will be issued. The course will end by 10pm.
