



Guidelines: How the MFIS Residential Sprinkler Program Works

1. All applications must be received by December 1 of each year.
2. Any MFIS member in good standing for the last three or more years can take part in the program.
3. The first step is to request an application to be part of the program. Online applications can be found under awards and scholarships at <http://www.mfis.org/awards-and-scholarships.html>
4. The MFIS board will approve a maximum of six project applications in the first year.
5. Following application approval by the MFIS board, the NFPA13 or 13D compliant sprinkler system must be installed and approved by local jurisdiction within 18 months of acceptance into the program.
6. Following the board's approval of the application, the owner or contractor must contact Viking Corporation, Duane Gilbert 269.945.8311, and advise them you are part of the MFIS Residential Sprinkler Program. When you show them your letter of acceptance they will provide all sprinkler heads needed for the project (provided your chosen installer uses Viking heads) free of charge.
7. The owners of the residential property are encouraged to use the following partners (sprinkler partner companies listed below), if you show participation in the MFIS Residential Sprinkler Program they will give you a \$500 discount off the total cost.

8. If you contact the following insurance companies, they may give a discount on your home insurance policy. If you work with an insurance company not listed, ask if they offer a discount when residential sprinklers are installed.
 - Liberty Insurance
 - State Farm
 - AAA
9. When the installation is complete and inspected by the authority having jurisdiction and given a final approval, send a copy of the approval to the MFIS Secretary /Treasurer. This shall be done within 18 months of acceptance into the program. The MFIS board will review the paperwork, if everything is properly completed the board will approve the project and send you a check for \$500.
