Three groups of officials are currently working to provide guidance to the Delaware Department of Education (DOE) as that agency considers reopening Delaware school facilities for the new school year.

In late April, Governor Carney closed Delaware public school buildings for the remainder of the 2019-2020 academic school year due to the perceived threat of COVID-19.

The working groups will focus on three points of policy: Health and Wellness; Academics and Equity; and Operations and Services.
