**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BLAIRSTOWN CHAPTER 171  
ARTICLE III “SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS”, SECTION 171-14 “SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS”**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Code contains a section regarding removal of snow, ice and dirt from sidewalks; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has reviewed the Code and determined that the section regarding removal of snow from driveways should be supplemented; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Blairstown, Warren County, New Jersey, that Article III “Snow from Driveways”, Section 171-14 entitled “Prohibition” of the Code of the Township of Blairstown be and is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 171, Article III Snow from Driveways shall be amended to read as follows:

**§171-14 Prohibition.**

- A. During and after the periods of snowfall, no person shall throw, shovel, push or blow snow from his driveway into the main portions of the roads plowed by the Township road crews, in the Township.
- B. Enforcement. This Section shall be enforced by the Township Police Department, Township Code Enforcement Official, or other authorized designee of the Township Committee.
- C. Violations and penalties. A violation of any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by one or more of the following:
  - 1. A fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$2,000.
  - 2. A period of community service not to exceed 30 days.

All other portions of this Chapter remain unchanged.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Blairstown inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This law shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
