Linelle thanks the board for approving her the new chairperson, looking forward to serving on the committee. Scholarship winner Marcella Bruns introduced herself,

attending ISU, studying in communications and political science.

- **Farm Progress:** Bob reported him and Jerry worked together, There were 4 4-H winners that brought projects. 826 and 350 tractors, a plow and pedal tractor, plus other displays. Location was good, we were well noticed.

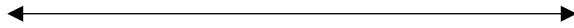

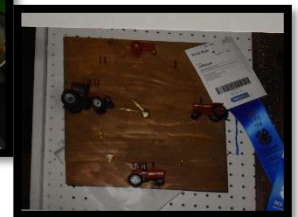

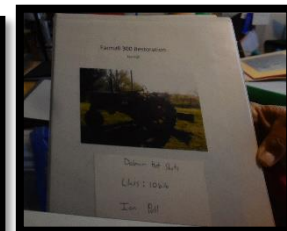
