Perl Steiner, age 80, longtime Bad Axe businessman, passed away Tuesday, Dec. 6 at his home after a short illness.

Mr. Steiner was born Dec. 13, 1907 in Lima, Ohio, son of the late Oscar and Amanda (Baumgardner) Steiner. He married Sadie Wilburn on Oct. 14, 1934 in Pigeon.

Mr. Steiner was a member of the Michigan Avenue Mennonite Church, Pigeon and an active member of the Gideon Association. He owned and operated Steiner Drapery and Upholstery, Bad Axe, founded in 1948.

Surviving are his wife, Sadie; one daughter, Mrs. Arnold (Donna) Beasley, Calif.; two brothers, Carlton Steiner and Weldon Steiner, both of Indiana; three sisters, Luella Steiner and Esther Fryar, both of Indiana and Gene Wagner, Florida; and one grandson.

Preceding him in death were two brothers, Clarence Steiner and Emmett Steiner.

Funeral services were conducted Friday, Dec. 9 at the Michigan Avenue Mennonite Church. Pastor Herb Troyer officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
