

**BOLD WARRIOR
BOY'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT
GRADE 4
SATURDAY, JANUARY 23, 2016**

*****The referees for this tournament are individuals from our community who have been involved with the game of basketball for a number of years. Please set a good example for all the kids in this tournament by refraining from any type of unsportsmanlike conduct directed at the referees. They will do the very best job they can!******

- Minnesota State High School League rules will apply with the following modifications.
- The home team will be the TEAM ON THE LEFT SIDE OF SCHEDULE.
- Each half will be 14 minutes running time. The last minute of the first half and the last 2 minutes of the game will be stop time unless a team has a 20 point lead.
- Each team will have 3 timeouts per game (1 minute each). Each team will have 1 timeout in overtime. No carryover.
- Half time will be 3 minutes.
- There will be a 3-5 minute warm up period between games depending on the schedule.
- 1st overtime will be 2 minutes long – stop time. 2nd overtime will be sudden death.
- Pressing ONLY in last 2 minutes of the game. NO pressing with a 15+ point lead. Pressing is allowed in overtime.
- NO ZONE DEFENSES. One warning will be given per team per game. After that, 2 points will be awarded.
- 4th Grade will use shorter free throw line (13' marked with tape). 4th Grade will be allowed to touch or cross over line as long as they start behind the line.
- No protests allowed. Official's decision is final.
- Restraining lines will be used at Bird Island's small gym.
- Technical fouls will NOT be shot. Two points and the ball will be awarded to the opponent of the team charged with a technical.
- If a team has only 5 players left in the game, no player shall foul out of the game after the 5th foul on a player. Subsequent fouls on that player will result in the fouled team being awarded two points and the ball, as in a technical.
- Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.
- Please give your lineups in numerical order to the official scorekeeper before the game.
- The tournament is on a tight schedule. Please make every effort to keep the games on time!
- BALLS WILL BE PROVIDED (PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY BALLS!)
- All participating teams shall be responsible for safety/wellbeing considerations for their players providing such items as first aid goods, etc. As per team registrations, participants agree to assume all responsibility, including insurance, for this tournament and waive any and all claims against tournament sponsors and/or directors, and the BOLD School District including, but not limited to, claims based on negligence.
