

DOROTHEA M. DIENER 1918 - 1993

Dorothea Maria Diener, 74 of Pigeon, passed away Thursday, May 13 at her home following a long illness.

Dorothea M. Strater was born in Bay City on June 15, 1918, daughter of the late Emil and Baldina (Schulze) Strater. On Feb. 2, 1936, she was united in marriage to John H. Diener in Wadsworth, OH. He survives her.
