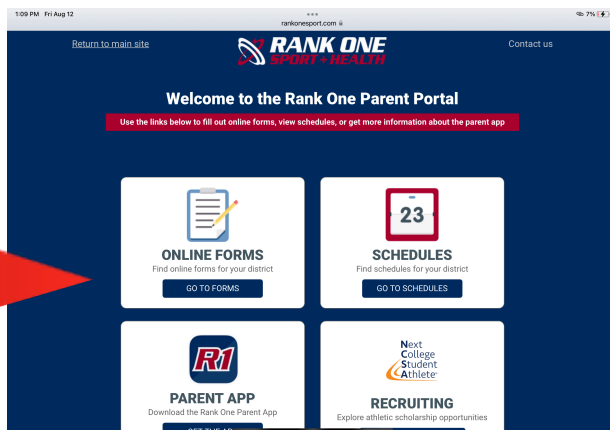

The Cushing Public Schools Athletic Department would like to thank you for taking part in our process of accepting the required athletic participation paperwork online.

- 1. You must print off a copy of the physical form and take it to the physician. It must be filled out and signed by a physician. If you took your physical in the Spring we should have it on file. HS students must hand deliver to the Athletic Director's office or you can scan and email to dusty.hancock@cushingtigers.com. Middle School students should give their physical form to their respective coach.
- 2. Remember to submit online, you and your student athlete must fill out and sign in all required spaces. Forms will not be accepted electronically without everything filled out by the student athlete and you the parent/guardian.
- 3. To access the required athletic participation forms for Cushing Public Schools, hold your cursor over the "ONLINE FORMS" tab. You will get a drop down list of all the required forms.
- 4. You will use your child's First Name, Last Name, and Birthdate to validate your student's record.
- 5. TO SIGN THE DOCUMENT, click inside the signature box and hold your mouse down, this will allow you to create an "electronic signature." If you make a mistake and need to start over click on the refresh icon next to the signature box. If you are using an iPad, you may create an electronic signature, by holding your finger to the screen and signing or by using a stylus pen and signing.
- 6. Once you have filled out all of the information on each page you will have the opportunity to print the document.

Student Conduct and Appearance Code
For
Extracurricular Activities

The administration of Cushing Public Schools recognizes the importance of student involvement in extracurricular activities. The administration encourages students to be actively involved in these activities. It is the expectation of the administration and sponsors/coaches that students that choose to be involved recognize the importance of proper student conduct and appearance when representing Cushing Public Schools.

The involvement in extracurricular activities is a choice that individual students make. The Supreme Court of the United States has ruled that students choosing to participate in extracurricular activities may be held to standards not applicable to the general student population.

The Cushing School Administration has determined the student conduct and appearance code will be based on the term "APPROPRIATE". The administration and/or sponsors will determine appropriate conduct and appropriate appearance required for involvement in these activities.

By signing this form the student and parent/guardian understand that involvement in extracurricular activities is a privilege and students will face consequences for violating appropriate conduct and/or appearance.

The following is a list to help students and parents/guardians become familiar with this policy.

1. The administration will determine appropriate conduct and appearance.
2. Sponsors/coaches may develop specific expectations for their activity.
3. Consequences may range from a warning to expulsion from all activities.
4. Sponsors/coaches may impose additional consequences.
5. Appropriate student conduct will be required at all times and is not limited to school hours or school events.
6. Athletic teams will dress in school colors only.
7. Inappropriate postings on the internet (My Space, Face Book, etc.) may lead to consequences.
8. A student with continued school discipline issues will be subject to this policy.

Drug and Alcohol Policy

Cushing Public Schools 2019/2020

EXTRA CURRICULAR POLICY FOR DRUGS AND ALCOHOL

It is the intent of the Board of Education, administration, coaches and sponsors to implement a policy that will be consistent and universal covering all extracurricular activities for Cushing Public Schools. Those students representing the school should maintain good citizenship and, as part of that obligation, refrain from violating the law (which would include underage drinking and use of illegal drugs) whether on or off the campus. Additionally, use of drugs and alcohol have been shown to have an adverse effect on students training for performance in many extracurricular activities.

In accordance with the policy of the Board of Education, the following procedures will be followed concerning drug and alcohol use by students involved in extracurricular activities. All students involved in extracurricular activities will be advised that the following procedures will be enforced throughout the calendar year (i.e. including after school, weekends and summer).

FIRST OFFENSE: Student will be held out a minimum of 20% of scheduled games or 4 weeks, depending on type of activity. First offense students will have a probation period of 1 year. With no other offenses within this probation period, the student's record will be cleared.

SECOND OFFENSE: Student will be held out of all extracurricular activities for one calendar year (ex. November 3, 2014 to November 3, 2015). If the student, after sitting out of activities for the aforementioned year, again commits an offense, he or she automatically receives second offense (on additional year of non-participation).

Verification: Offenses will be verified by (1) law enforcement agencies, (2) school personnel, (3) self- confession.

Any students involved in other illegal activities may be subject to the above mentioned penalties.
