**Correspondence/Announcements:**

- **The Trustees were approved for a Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant in the amount of \$12,000.00 from the OhioBWC.** The grant will be used to help purchase 90 hoods and 90 pairs of gloves for our firefighters. The total cost for this equipment is \$14,400.00 and the Township will contribute \$2,400.00 towards the purchase.
- **The Trustees submitted petitions for water service in the Stillwagon Road area of the Township to the Trumbull County Sanitary Engineer's Office.** The Trumbull County Commissioner's at their regular meeting on August 1<sup>st</sup> voted to receive the petitions and will now begin the next steps of the process.
- **The Trustees would like to remind our residents of the 2018 Residential Tree Limb Chipping Program.** The 2018 Residential Tree Limb Chipping Program began on Friday, April 2<sup>7th</sup>, 2018 and will continue each Friday through Friday, October 2<sup>6th</sup>, 2018. For tree limb pick-up, you must call the Township by Thursday of each week to be placed on the list for a Friday pick-up. Please keep the following rules and procedures in mind:
  - This program is intended for residential tree limbs up to 3 inches in diameter.
  - The tree limbs must be placed at the curbside with all the cut ends aligned with each other toward the street.
  - No shrubs, stumps, roots, lumber, or rail road ties will be accepted. All tree limbs must be free from vines.
  - We are not a tree removal service; if you are having a tree professionally removed let them do the entire job, you must have them take the tree limbs as well.
