Holy Water and Whiskey (Bruce and Maggie Washburne and Amy Blackburn) has been around since 2003 and has won several New Mexico music awards – most often for a capella tunes like Night Hymn – a song about the stars at Chaco Canyon – and Mary Had A Baby – a hymn from slave communities off the coast of South Carolina. The third award was for Fancy Red Boots – an age-appropriate song about not being dead yet and being glad to not wake up in jail. HWW is known for their choice of songs, their authenticity, and jokes that might leave you asking for more music. All the members of Holy Water and Whiskey are singers, while Bruce plays 6 and 12-string guitar and banjo, Amy plays fiddle, mandolin, and guitar, and Maggie plays bass.
