

## Horse Show Notes – Western Division

- Must show at 3 of the 4 shows to be eligible for year end awards
- We will be offering high point awards for each show, for exhibitors with the most points in the following categories.
  1. All around adult
  2. All around novice adult
  3. All around youth
  4. All around adult walk/jog
  5. All around youth walk/jog
  6. All around performance horse
- Everyone must show proof of insurance (Current OEF Membership or through your home insurance)
- **Novice Adult:** Any horse/rider combination which have not shown at any open schooling shows, or other recognized breed show or have earned more than 3 first place finishes at a DHRC show in the respective class in the competition year. (If you start as a novice, you will remain a novice for the completion of that year)
- **Green Horse:** horses not ready to lope / canter
- **Lead Line:** Not eligible to ride alone in any other class, must be led by a person 16 years or older and must wear a riding helmet
- **Walk Trot / Jog Division** - Exhibitors cannot enter other classes with a lope / canter
- **Junior Horse** - 5 years of age and under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the competition year
- **Senior Horse** – 6 years and over as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the competition year
- **Youth RIDER** – Exhibitor 18 years and younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the competition year (note: must wear a helmet)
- **Adult RIDER** – 19 & over as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the competition year
- If you rented a stall, please be sure to clean it out before you leave
- Bitless bridles will be assessed on a per case bases. If you wish to ride your horse in a bitless bridle, please contact the western directors prior to the show so the committee can assess the situation and approve. Our goal is to ensure all horses are under control at all times and in no way will pose a safety issue with you or other rider/horse combinations

At the end of the day, we want our shows to be a fun experience for our exhibitors. We will strive to offer a safe, friendly, rewarding experience for you and your horse! We are here to help with any questions or concerns you may have, so be sure to contact us if you need answers.
