

A Checklist of Things to Know Before You Show:

- Before filling out the individual Show Form, you will need to have done the following to get your Rider / Owner / Horse registered:
- Register your Rider/Join the U.S. Equestrian Federation at **USEF.org**
- Register your Rider / Join the West TN Hunter Jumper Association at **WTHJA.com**
- Have your Horse Microchipped
- Have your Horse Measured
- Make sure your Horse's vaccinations / Coggins Test is current
- Register your Horse at **USEF.org**
- If the Owner of your Horse is not the Rider, you must also register the Owner and purchase a USEF membership for the Owner
- Register your Horse at **WTHJA.org**
- If you plan to Show Internationally*, complete the FEI Registration at USEF.org; if not, you do not need to register for FEI
- Print the "Horse Card" using the icon on your Horse's USEF page (found when you select COMPETE / SEARCH HORSES / HORSE ID), for any inquiries that come up at the Show.
- Print a Show Schedule and Show Entry Form off of the website of the individual Show you are competing in.
