MEMBER NEWS

The Capitol Improvement Committee has recommended to the Board and was approved to present to the membership the following 3 line items.

1g: True 3 door upright (kitchen) – expected life expired 2018-2021. This unit frequently goes down resulting in the loss of thousands of dollars in food. Cost \$9600+ installation.

1j: Back beer cooler behind bar – to rebuild, most cost effective option is to replace condenser lines and two new units in existing. Cost of \$6000+ electrical & installation, (a saving of \$10,000 and will require no mill work).

5c: Add awning door to door near pool table/bar area. Cost not to exceed \$1700. (current quote of \$1668.71) These items will be discussed at the April 4, 2022 Membership Meeting.
