WHO IS STRD?



We are a group of Off Roaders that banded together in 2009 when we finally realized that the US Forest Service (USFS) was not done closing more of the Oregon Dunes to the sport we love. From 1972 to 1994, by law, 75% of the dunes were closed to riding. During that time, 50% of open sand was lost to very aggressive vegetation. The USFS needs a new direction. The new Plan Cycle is due to begin in 2018 and history is not on our side. The time to do something is now! STRD has involved the counties, our legislators, and has worked with the USFS. We now have a place at the table.

WHAT'S OUR GOAL?

Our goal is to use 100% of the money raised to help guide the Forest Service's focus from closure to restoration and open up more area to riding. STRD has partnered with the Blue Ribbon Coalition (BRC) who is a national organization with the best land use advocates in the nation. HOW TO ACCESS QR CODES AND UPLOAD GPS MAPS

The USFS GPS enabled PDF maps can be easily uploaded on a **smart phone**. You do NOT need any special equipment or knowledge, just a basic understanding of how phone apps work.

QR code reader is a fun must!

- 1. Go to your smart phone's App store.
- 2. Search for QR Code Reader and install into your phone (free and your phone may already come with it installed)
- 3. Search for Avenza PDF Maps App (free); install into your phone.
- 4. "Read" the QR code below by going in to the newly installed QR Code App on your phone. This opens to the USFS Website with the three free PDF Maps. You now need to upload all three maps into your phone's newly installed PDF Maps.
- 5. To accomplish this upload, select the first map. It will upload on your phone. Once it's there, look for the 3 dots icon in the upper right hand corner of the map. Select the 3 dots, then a menu comes up; select "open with". Then a new menu opens where you can choose "open with PDF Maps". All phones are different. This process can take a few minutes. 6. Repeat step 5 for the remaining two maps.
- 7. A great way to make this easier is to input all the geocaching coordinates from home. Once you have purchased a ticket or two, then go to our website and copy all the 21 coordinates at the same time. Go to PDF Maps on your phone and select the correct map with the correct coordinates for that map. Open that map and on the left side you will see a wrench Icon. Open the wrench and one of the options is to "Find by Coordinates". Enter the coordinates and hit OK. That brings you to the exact coordinates in the map. (If the coordinates don't come up, you've selected the wrong map for the coordinates). Before you do anything

else you need to "PIN" that spot. In the upper right hand corner you will see a Pin Icon. Touch that and the pin will go to the spot and save it with option to rename. The options are endless. You can enter all 21 spots before you leave home and have plenty of time to find all 21 spots during the summer!

RULES OF GEOCACHING:

- 1. There is a total of 21 spots (coordinates); 7 in each of 3 riding areas: Florence/Winchester Bay/Coos Bay.

- 4. The Wednesday before each weekend, we will publish on STRD's Facebook page, a time, place and three randomly selected coordinates for that riding area. An STRD member at the coordinate will award the prize after you present your original raffle ticket stub or email.

 5. For example: "In Florence between 10AM-12PM Sat. May 14, we will be at one of the these three coordinates: 43.XXX.-124.XXX/43.XXX.-124.XXX/43.XXX.-124.XXXX. Come find us!" With the exception of time and coordinates, the same info will be sent for Winchester and Coos Bay.
- 6. Each coordinate will have a unique QR Code on a green stake. The code contains a short video of what makes that coordinate unique.
